2021 SPALC Contract Ratification - Voting Instructions

The 2021 SPALC Contract Ratification ballot will open for voting Tuesday, January 19th at 6:00am, and end Wednesday, January 20th at 6:00pm. **Please read these instructions before you vote**.

NOTE: The website is user-friendly, and voters should be able to complete the vote within one minute if the SPALC Tentative Agreement document has been reviewed prior to voting.

Steps to voting

- 1) **Read the SPALC Tentative Agreement** this document can be found within the email you received with these instructions, at the Island Coast-FEA (SPALC) website https://www.islandcoastfea.org/spalc, or on the eballot iteself.
- 2) Open email with ballot login credentials (received 1/19/2021)
- 3) Click on link inside email to voting website (eballot)
- 4) Enter your DID (Username) and Password (found in email), on eBallot Login Page
- 5) Make voting selection, then click "NEXT" tab
- 6) Confirm choice selected and check "Participant Consent" box, then click SUBMIT tab
- 7) Confirmation page will display, and you may "view your receipt" from this page
- 8) Click "Logout"

Accessing the Ballot and your Login Password:

Tuesday, January 19th you will receive an email from Carolyn Hutto, SPALC Elections Administrator (see below)—You may receive the email prior to 6am, however, **voting will not open until 6am**.

Steps 2 & 3

NOTICE: This message originated outside of the District's network and MAY BE A SCAM. Please do not share personal information unless you are certain of the authenticity of the message.

NOTE: Although you will see this red "NOTICE", this email is legit. This red notice is automatically generated because the email originates from Votenet, although it is created by the SPALC Elections Administrator, Carolyn Hutto.

In this email you will *receive* <u>the voting link</u> and <u>your password</u>. You must open this email to get your password to vote. You will need to *copy & paste* OR *make note of your password* and then click on the Website link.

Login Credentials

USER ID:

Your user ID <u>is</u> your <u>DID#</u> (if you do not know your DID, you need to find out from your principal's secretary). Carolyn Hutto cannot give you your DID.

PASSWORD:

Your password can be found in the email that you receive on January 19th, with the subject line: LCSD 2021 SPALC Contract Ratification: Voting Opens @ 6am!

Troubleshooting - Ballot Access

<u>IF you receive a message that you have no ballot</u>, please try again and be sure to CLEAR your password if it fills automatically --- You will need to type or copy & paste your password.

If for any reason you are not able to access the ballot by using the link provided, please use the actual website address: https://eballot4.votenet.com/SPALC

Remember, you need your password from the email you receive on 1/19/2021 from Carolyn Hutto (via Votenet) BEFORE you can vote!

Please try and troubleshoot BEFORE emailing Carolyn Hutto. This is the primary reason why a voter is unable to access their ballot. Once you have tried troubleshooting, then email Carolyn Hutto at spalcelections@islandcoastfea.org

Be sure to include your Legal Name and your DID for identification purposes in your email to Carolyn.

It is recommended that all voters login to the voting website on the first day of voting, Tuesday, September 19th. This way if there is a problem logging in, Carolyn will have time to rectify the situation. If you attempt to log in on September 20th <u>after 4:00 pm</u> and have trouble, it may be difficult to fix the problem in time. Please plan accordingly.
