GENERAL COUNSEL'S NOTICE OF SUFFICIENCY

On August 10, 2021, an unfair labor practice charge was filed pursuant to section 447.503(1), Florida Statutes (2020), and Florida Administrative Code Rule 60CC-5.001. Upon consideration of the charge and any supporting documents filed with the charge, I have determined the charge is sufficient.

The Commission utilizes e-service as the primary method of delivery of orders, correspondence, and notices. It is incumbent upon parties to ensure their e-mail address on file with the Commission is correct and current. Parties may utilize the Commission's secure web-based portal, called "ePERC," to file documents electronically and view filings in their case. Information on how to sign up and use ePERC can be found at <http://perc.myflorida.com/co/eperc.aspx>.

Pursuant to section 447.503(2)(b), Florida Statutes (2020), the Respondent shall file an answer to the charge with the Commission and serve a copy on the Charging Party, no later than twenty days after issuance of this Notice. The Respondent may obtain copies of the supporting documents submitted by the Charging Party by making a request to the Clerk of the Commission or registering for ePERC and appearing in the case.

Because this case may involve disputed issues of material fact, an evidentiary hearing will be scheduled within forty-five days from the date of the notice of sufficiency. Pursuant to section 120.569(2)(b), Florida Statutes (2020), the assigned hearing officer will be issuing a notice of hearing specifying the time, date, and place of the evidentiary hearing at least fourteen days prior to the hearing.

All parties are advised to review Chapter 447, Part II, Florida Statutes (2020). The parties are also urged to review the Uniform Rules of Procedure, which can be found in the Florida Administrative Code at Chapter 28, paying particular attention to 28-106.201 through .217.
